9 Q. Isn't it true, in fact, that on that day you were
10 working it in that same fashion that you are today, opening
11 and closing it?

12 A. No, it is not, because at that time the situation
13 was much worse. That hand was closed.

14 Q. You were completely unable to open that hand?

15 A. That's correct. I could do it by opening it this
16 way, with my other hand, but it would not open itself. It
17 was paralyzed.

18 Q. Okay. Now, Mr. Murray, I believe you are still
19 wearing that shoulder brace, is that right --

20 A. Yes, sir.

21 Q. -- beneath your jacket?

22 A. Uh-huh.

23 Q. And is that for the purposes of the demonstration
24 that you were engaging in earlier?

25 A. Right.
