

1 Q. Okay.

2 A. This hand was paralyzed, the arm -- I had limited
3 use of the arm, as was in Mr. Sahli's deposition. I've
4 gotten better in the last ten months.

5 Q. So you had less range of motion and flexibility
6 in the arm at the time; is that right?

7 A. That's right. I didn't walk as well then either,
8 as I do now, because I had to have a walker then.

9 Q. Uh-huh. And that shoulder brace, you testified,
10 is exactly the same one that you were wearing that day?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. Let me get back for a moment to the question of
13 what you said, if anything, as Mr. Sahli was approaching.
14 Do you recall at all saying anything as Mr. Sahli
15 approached?

16 A. Sir, as I said before, I don't recall what I may
17 have said or what I may not have said. It happened in an
18 instant. I was focused on my neck and on getting my
19 balance. And if somebody said, as they testified
20 yesterday, take it, take it, I may have said that. I know
21 one thing I did not say was the word camera, because I
22 didn't know what was in my face and jeopardizing my neck.

23 Q. How far away from your face was that object when
24 you turned around?

25 A. It was right there, like this (indicating).
